Classic hard-bop never sounded so easy, and fresh. The Jazz at Lincoln Center Orchestra with Wynton Marsalis arranges tunes from the Golden Era of the Blue Note catalogue: Herbie Hancock's Maiden Voyage and Wayne Shorter's Infant Eyes and Bud Powell's Un Poco Loco (*Murray Street Productions*)

Indigenous music from around the world Mongolian Sounds: Egschiglen Egschiglen is a Mongolian folk ensemble formed in the early 1990s by students from the Conservatoire of Ulan Bator. The ensemble plays traditional pieces and works by contemporary Mongolian composers on a range of traditional instruments including the morin khuur (horse-head violin), jochin (*dulcimer*), and tobshuur (*swan neck lute*). Added to this is the distinctive sound of khoomii, a special kind of throat-singing (ARC Music EUCD 1652; Heaven and Earth HE17)
