piece for JALC. In this House, On this Morning takes the form of a church service, packing brimstone, fire and a "Sweet Embrace" in the hands of drummer Herlin Riley, saxophonists Wess "Warmdaddy" Anderson and Todd Williams, trombonist Wycliffe Gordon and "Swing Doom", bassist Reginald Veal. With Marsalis on trumpet they give old Joshua some stiff competition in Call to Prayer, In this House, Altar Call and more (*Murray Street Productions*)
