Six composers, David Hamilton, Anthony Ritchie, Jeff Lin, Anthony Young, Penny Dodd and Matthew Crawford, had written vocal pieces which were worked on by NZ Opera Dame Malvina Major Emerging Artists and the orchestra with conductor Hamish McKeich.
