musician caste. His latest album, Courage, is
a departure from the traditional melodies on
his previous album, focussing instead on
Diabaté's own compositions (*World Village

Atongoimba and his signature two-stringed
calabash lute, the koliko, are joined by a
variety of strings and percussion in this
album. "This is very acoustic music, it's with
the acoustic sound of the Sahel", explains
